“Science@Stockmen’s Park” Begins June 26th

Quest Science Center will host a series of five Saturday programs at Stockmen’s Park in Livermore beginning June 26th with “The Science of Bubbles.” From June through October, the programs will be held once a month for two-to-three-hours each and feature fun activities, stage shows, music and more.

The series is designed to explore science in our community and our natural world, and is free, appropriate and accessible for all audiences. The community is welcome to drop by any time during the program to participate.

“We’re excited to bring this science series to the general public at the future home of Quest Plaza and the Quest Science Center,” says Chief Learning Officer Caleb Cheung. “There is so much happening around us and we look forward to celebrating and exploring science in our community together this summer.”

Join us for any or all of these fun events:

- June 26 (10 am – 12 pm) - ***The Science of Bubbles***
 - Beyond fun, what makes a bubble a bubble? Learn about surface tension and colors, make bubble wands and solution, and help us set the record for the most bubbles in Livermore!
- July 17 (5 pm – 8 pm)- ***The Science of Perception***
 - Through the art of magic, we’ll explore how illusions trick the senses and why we find them so entertaining! This program features a special magic show that adults and children will enjoy!
- August 7 (5 pm – 8 pm) – ***The Science of Music***
 - Anyone can create musical sounds! Join us as we build instruments from household materials and experiment with sound waves. Play the [Space Palette Pro](#). The evening ends with an incredible performance by local electronic music inventor and pioneer Don Lewis.

- September 4 (12 pm – 3 pm) – ***The Science of Water***
 - What makes water so special and important to living things? We'll explore the nature of water and how it plays a critical role in our environment, and learn about conservation efforts to protect this vital resource.
- October 2 (4 pm – 7 pm) – The Science of Engineering
 - Experience the engineering design cycle as you create rockets, boats, bridges, catapults, and more! Challenges for aspiring engineers of all ages and experience levels.
